



Primary ITO NZ Apiculture Apprenticeship Scholarship Conditions and Eligibility

We are giving learners in the apiculture industry, who are eligible (as outlined in these conditions and a Primary ITO Training Agreement), the opportunity to apply for a NZ Apprenticeship Scholarship.

Conditions:

1. Only the scholarship recipients, who are employed in the apiculture industry, are entitled to redeem the scholarship for the fees of an apprenticeship as stated on the Primary Industry Training Organisation (Primary ITO) NZ Apprenticeship programme list°.
2. The scholarship does not include provider late marking fees (for assessments or evidence portfolio work) occurred during the period of the apprenticeship or for any additional elective units selected by the recipient.
3. The recipient must meet the criteria as outlined in a Primary ITO Training Agreement.
4. By applying for a scholarship, applicants are deemed to have accepted these NZ Apiculture Apprenticeship Scholarship Conditions.
5. Each Primary ITO NZ Apiculture Apprenticeship Scholarship is not transferable, exchangeable nor redeemable for cash.
6. A Primary ITO Training Adviser will review all applications in the region and industry they support, and those meeting eligibility and acceptance will have the programme fee for the full duration of their NZ Apprenticeship, paid for by Primary ITO. This excludes any elective unit fees associated with the NZ Apprenticeship.
7. Decisions of Primary ITO on aspects of the scholarship eligibility for each applicant are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Eligibility for a NZ Apprenticeship scholarship is outlined as follows:

1. Aged 16 years of age or older (under 16's need a Ministry of Education exemption).
2. Meet the full conditions of a Primary ITO Training Agreement.
3. Working in an occupation relating to the apprenticeship (apiculture industry), with the intention and ability to complete their apprenticeship.
4. An employee who is legally entitled to work in New Zealand, working under an Employment Agreement. People who are legally working in New Zealand under a working visa arrangement (and meet the conditions of a training agreement) are eligible to apply.
5. A self-employed contractor who has a formal training agreement with the same organisation with which they have a contract of service.
6. A volunteer in an arrangement in the nature of employment, who has a training agreement with the host organisation. Any new volunteer enrolments require TEC approval. Voluntary organisations are those that usually have a charitable purpose who perform a public good, employed in an industry under Primary ITO's gazette coverage.
7. If the applicant is a currently enrolled into a training programme with Primary ITO, you need to discuss this application with your Primary ITO Training Adviser as you may be ineligible to apply for the scholarship.
